How it all began

I was always fascinated by science, even as a kid. In fact, after 'being sensible' and completing my training as a management assistant in wholesale and foreign trade, I decided to follow my dreams: I went to college to study biochemistry and physiology.

I started my academic career at the famous University of Tübingen, the first university worldwide to offer a course of study in biochemistry. After getting my masters in biochemistry and physiology there, I moved on to the renowned Max Planck Institute for Medical Research in Heidelberg, where I had the privilege of working with professors who had won the Nobel Prize. Later, I went to work for the pharmaceuticals industry, developing, licensing, and registering all sorts of drugs and medical products.

However, like many people, I got back pain at an early age. My problem was a common one: the underside of my vertebrae had become weak

and porous, allowing the fluid in my spinal disks to create an uneven surface. The bumps on my vertebrae and spinal disks constantly rubbed against each other, causing severe inflammation, muscle tension, and pain. My back prevented me from living my life the way I wanted. The constant pain kept getting worse and spread to other parts of the body. Skiing and bicycling were suddenly things of the past. Even sitting, standing, or lying down for long periods of time were increasingly painful. It was clear I had to do something.

I went to my doctor thinking that since my problem was common, finding relief must be easy. My doctor did the right thing and prescribed medication. I took it and the pain went away. However, shortly thereafter, my pain came back. No matter how much more medicine I took or how well I followed my doctor's instructions or which doctor I went to see, my back pain just wouldn't go away and stay away.

Because conventional medicine just wasn't doing the trick, I began looking for alternatives.

As people with a chronic condition often do, I tried everything to get relief. Massage helped, but only for awhile. I changed my diet, which helped me feel better, but my back still hurt. Acupuncture, chiropractic, herbal supplements, minerals, essential oils, and nearly everything else – you name it, I tried it – helped a little, but not enough and not for good. Even if I felt better for a while, the pain still came back sooner or later.

Finally, I went to see a homeopathic practitioner in hope of finding relief. It was my last resort, and I wasn't sure if it would work. After all, I was a biochemist, and allegedly, 'real scientists' shouldn't have anything to do with homeopathy. However, I overcame my doubts and tried something new.

The seemingly simple wisdom of finding a way to help the body help itself did the trick. Many physical adjustments coupled with a plethora of plant-based homeopathic remedies, dietary supplements, and local anesthetic intramuscular and subcutaneous injections (all specially selected for my personal needs) helped make my back hurt less and less until – one day – my back pain was gone for good. While I had now turned into a 'true believer' in homeopathy, I wasn't 100% happy with everything about my treatment. The process of getting better took nearly two years, which was longer than I had expected. Often, much of my treatment seemed like trial and error.

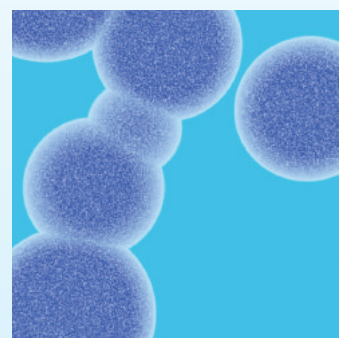
is the right choice for another patient.

So, ultimately, homeopathy made my life better, although it took a long time and didn't always make much sense. The researcher in me wanted to know if there was a simpler and faster way to heal homeopathically that people could easily understand. My goal was to find out which substances were the remedies of choice for the largest number of patients to make it possible to heal illness quickly and effectively so that other people wouldn't have to go through the same long and confusing process that I had.

I was well aware of the difficulty facing me, but I also knew that I was up to the challenge. After all, by this time, I had already built up a successful consulting company, developing, licensing, and registering drugs, supplements, and cosmetics for some of Germany's biggest names in natural medicine. My professional background in research and development and my expertise in biochemistry, pharmaceutical production, and natural healing gave me the tools and the confidence I needed to find a new way to promote and maintain health.

Because of my heartfelt yearning to do something groundbreaking with long-term potential, I began looking for healing substances which, up until then, had barely been explored. Medicinal plants and minerals had been researched and documented, and very clearly had their limits. I wondered: what else is out there to foster long-term health for as many people as possible?

Common sense told me that there was no way I could experiment on every healing substance the world had to offer. My education and experience taught me that if I wanted to make a difference in people's health by fostering lasting self-healing, I had to find substances that our bodies use to build a healthy immune system. I needed to find something we naturally come into contact with starting as babies that accompanies us our entire lives.

I got to thinking. Which substances are responsible for helping us develop the immune system we so need to survive and stay healthy? With which substances do we come into natural contact starting at birth?

The answer: microorganisms! From cradle to grave, we are surrounded by germs, bacteria, and thousands of species of microorganisms. Even if we tried, we couldn't avoid them. More or less, they're everywhere, and that's a good thing! Without microorganisms, life simply couldn't exist.

I just knew that microorganisms were the way to go. But the biggest challenge had just begun: I had to find out exactly which microorganisms of the thousands upon thousands out there were capable of effectively healing as many people as possible.

My scientific background taught me that only a biochemical screening system could do just that. I now had to find out which microorganisms to screen. Because there are billions of different species of microorganisms in the world, I knew that screening every single sort of microbe would take decades and cost a fortune to complete. I needed to focus and set my sights on those microorganisms with which we come in contact starting at birth. I had to find microorganisms that are in our food, on our clothes, in our homes, and in the air, and therefore most likely instrumental in forming a fully functioning immune system starting in early childhood.

For example, to determine which single remedies were most effective for treating allergies, I tested immune cells to see their reaction to various homeopathically prepared microorganism-based extracts. A homeopathic remedy successfully 'passed the test' if it was able to activate cellular biochemical mechanisms which are known to cause the immune reactions needed to fight allergies.



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I worked day and night on my research, occasionally taking time to reflect on my surprising and encouraging findings. Vienna's Institute of Cancer Research. The professor had developed a screening system that allowed him to investigate the influence of a substance on even the most complex mixtures of different types of immune cells simultaneously. More amazingly, he used immune cells freshly harvested from human blood!

I was excited and contacted Prof. Gerner right away. He was skeptical whether a homeopathic substance was even capable of showing a biochemical effect, but I was able to convince him to give us a chance. He agreed to do one single trial.
